Q: How do I access the collection?

Q: What is the **Panther Travel Collection**?

A: The **Panther Travel Collection** is a digital collection presenting images, video and audio related to the travels of UWM students across the globe. Currently the continents of Asia, Europe, and North America and the countries of Austria, Belgium, China, England, France, India, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Northern Ireland, Mexico, Nepal, Puerto Rico, Russia, Scotland, Thailand, and Turkey are represented.

There is coverage of both natural and manmade resources. Religious, educational, and cultural facilities and activities are depicted from the ancient to the modern world. Scenes are both urban and rural, and some examples include buildings and other architectural works, parks, gardens, sculptures and archeological sites. In addition the collection features a select number of digital scans of ephemera and links to webpages related to these locations.

Q: How do I browse the collection?

A: This collection is able to be browsed by selecting the **Browse/Search** tab on the top navigation bar. An additional browsing option is to browse the **suggested topics** via the lower left navigation bar on the **Browse/Search** tab.

Q: How do I search the collection?

A: This collection is able to be searched via the search bar available on the **Browse/Search** tab under the main

collection navigation tabs. An alternative is to search via the **Advanced Search** option located to the immediate right of the search button. This collection is able to be searched in **Advanced Search** by entering terms in the search box then limiting the fields to the following: **All fields, Title, Artist's Note, Artist, Location of Work,** and **Subject.**

Q: How can this collection's resources be interacted with?

A: Every resource in this collection (except audio and video resources) have the following options:

- **Reference URL** which can be provided if clicked. A URL that links back to the resource or a URL to embed the resource HTML into a website are provided.
- **Share** them on your choice of multiple social media platforms.
- **Tag** them with suggested subjects to aid in resource searchability.
- **Comment** on them to let the community know what you think!
- **Display** options to zoom in/out, view in full browser, view in fit to window, view in fit to width, rotate left/right.
- **Download** them in your choice of two sizes.
- **Print** them out to enjoy!

Q: What is the goal of this digital collection project?

A: The goal of this project is to share the travel experiences of UWM students with the hope of contributing to the expansion in knowledge of the world around us.

Q: What about copyright laws?

A: The resources in this collection may be downloaded or printed by individuals or libraries for personal use, research, teaching, or
